Since the inaugural Women in Aviation International (WAI) – Girls in Aviation Day (GIAD) in 2015, the annual global event has grown significantly, now engaging more than 40,000 participants across over 100 events in 18 countries and celebrating its 11th year internationally.

Women in Aviation International is a nonprofit organization dedicated to the encouragement and advancement of women across all aviation and aerospace career fields.

Girls in Aviation Day is a flagship WAI initiative with a primary audience of girls aged 8–17, their families, and educators, while also welcoming broader community participation to help raise awareness of aviation and aerospace career pathways.

GIAD Alberta Impact & Recognition:

GIAD Alberta has grown into a nationally and internationally recognized event. In 2025, the Alberta event achieved the following milestones:

- Ranked top 10 largest GIAD events worldwide out of approximately 200 events
- Recognized as the largest GIAD event in Western Canada
- Ranked among the top three largest international (non-U.S.) GIAD events out of 64 global international events

These achievements reflect the strength of community partnerships, industry engagement, and growing interest in aviation and aerospace careers across Alberta.

DESCRIPTION:

The event will be structured as a trade show with interactive activities, food trucks, exhibitors, and informational and educational displays aimed at offering an enjoyable and enlightening experience.

The objective of this event is to showcase the diverse career opportunities available within the aviation industry and to inspire girls and youth to explore future pathways in this field. Exhibitors are encouraged to share their knowledge and experiences through engaging, hands-on displays that spark curiosity.

ATTENDEES:

Attendees will include girls and youth between the ages of 8 - 17, along with members of the broader community who are interested in learning more about aviation. Exhibitors will play a key role in engaging with attendees by providing interactive, age-appropriate experiences that encourage questions, learning, and meaningful connections.



EXHIBITOR DETAILS

EXHIBITOR IDENTIFICATION

Each exhibitor will receive identification passes that must be worn during the event to ensure seamless identification and access. We're excited about the prospect of your participation and the collective impact we can make on Girls in Aviation Day. We look forward to your involvement in this enriching event.

EXHIBITOR SPACE

We have developed a preliminary lay-out for the exhibition area at the Gord Scott Aviation Services Hangar A at the Red Deer Regional Airport, where there will be ample room to accommodate many types of displays. There is power available and we are open to working with you on a setup that will best meet your needs.

Event is indoors (aircrafts, large displays are outdoors)

Space includes: 10x10 space which includes 1- 6ft table, 2 chairs, power if required.

Exhibitors are responsible for activity supplies, display and signage. We highly recommend your exhibit space be interactive to captivate the attention of the girls ages 8-17 years. Please let us know what activity you will have in your space and how much space you require on the exhibitor form. Form is available by QR code below.

SET UP & TEAR DOWN

Drop off supplies (if required): Friday, September 18, 2026 1:00 pm - 4:00 pm

Setup: Saturday, September 19, 2026 9:00 am - 10:30 am

Tear down: Saturday, September 19, 2026 4:00 pm - 5:00 pm

Tear down to take place no earlier than a ½ hour following the show and all products need to be removed, as there will be no overnight security.





EXHIBITOR DETAILS

EXHIBITOR RULES & REGULATIONS

Exhibitors must provide liability Insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000.

This is a NO FLY DAY, as per our insurance policy, we can not offer rides on event day.

You can offer prizes through a draw box from your space (including flights, but not on event day).

No exhibitor shall consume or have in their possession any alcohol or controlled substance
All spaces must be manned during the event.

Balloons are NOT allowed as give away items. Any inflatable objects used in displays, must be safely secured and attached to such displays and must be 5 feet above the ground.

Promotional materials may only be distributed from designated space only.

Food and beverages may only be sold at your designated space.

CANCELLATION OF EXHIBITOR SPACE

Inclement weather will not be accepted as a reason for cancellation. The Girls in Aviation Day will go on regardless of weather. If for some reason you have to cancel your space, please let us know no later than September 1, 2026.
